FoodInSpace Awards 2024 finalists announced.

Milan, Nov. 11, 2024 - FoodInSpace, the web magazine dedicated exclusively to global Food&Beverage concepts, announces the finalists for the first edition of the FoodInSpace Awards.

The FoodInSpace Awards 2024 feature 58 finalists in 29 categories. More than 250 entries were reviewed by a panel of 16 judges from 10 countries.

The international jury of experts made up of renowned architects, designers, interior designers, and food & beverage and design experts, called upon to vote in recent weeks, with the input of the popular vote cast on the foodinspace.com portal, identified the finalist projects that will compete for the title in the two macro categories in the competition, Concept Projects and Space Projects, and in the twenty-nine sub-categories provided in this first edition of the award, an expression of the multiple sensibilities on food&beverage of studios, architects and designers from around the world. Starting today, the announcement of the finalists is in fact kicked off, effectively starting the countdown that will lead to discovering the winners of all categories on November 18.
